


Day 1 - Arrivals

Arrival in Buenos Aires & Transfer to selected hotel

Option 1. Recoleta Walking Tour & coffee stop at traditional Cafe La Biela

This wonderful district is known for its squares, parks, cafés and one of Argentina's most important cemeteries, which holds Evita Peron's much-visited grave.

Beautiful churches, cultural centers and galleries like the Palais de Glace, fill the neighborhood with culture and history. It has been referred to as the Paris of the Americas due to the many palaces and villas in the area, which also offers sophisticated restaurants, up-scale shopping and the city's most luxurious hotels.

Recoleta is an upmarket neighborhood defined by old-world prestige. The grand French architecture from the early 20th century combined with the the backgrounds of the residents as members of the European elite make it clear why Buenos Aires has become known as the Paris of South America.





Option 2. Puerto Madero Walking Tour

The newest and most contemporary neighborhood of Buenos Aires, the development of Puerto Madero has brought Buenos Aires into the 21st century. Modern real estate and high-rise office buildings form a new kind of skyline, towering above an upscale promenade of riverfront bars and restaurants.

It's an ideal venue for a welcome cocktail reception and private dinner, where we can include any type of entertainment to make it a fun night.












Option 3. Welcome Dinner at Faena Art Center

Highlights of Buenos Aires with individual experiences.


Discover the interesting history of Buenos Aires through its most famous neighborhoods.

Finally, visit Palermo and its most exclusive residential areas.








Optional - Surprises appearances

Individual Experiences

1. Tango Lessons at Typical Conventillo in La Boca

Argentine Tango is an interpretive, improvisational social dance that allows the dancers to develop a deep connection between themselves, the music, and the environment in which they are dancing.

You will be introduced to the Sultry Dance of Tango, learning the basic steps at a real conventillo in the traditional neighborhood of "La Boca", the place where the Tango history started.



2. Wine Tasting

In a country renowned for its excellent wines, few can match the superb quality.

Is your chance to sample some of the wineries best vintages, under expert tutelage, and in the luxury of a magnificent French-style mansion.







3. Special Visit at Colon Theatre

Located in the heart of Buenos Aires sits Teatro Colón, one of the most famous opera houses on the planet. Ranked the third best opera house in the world, by National Geographic, it is consistently ranked in the top five concert venues on the Earth, thanks to its flawless acoustics.

Guests who visit will have the opportunity to experience firsthand the beauty and majesty of the renovated theatre. The hour-long tour will teach visitors about the history of the theatre and allow them to explore behind the curtains of this treasured piece of Argentinian cultural heritage: into the underground tunnels, the practice rooms, and backstage.



4. Cooking Lessons at Espacio Azai

Cooking encourages teamwork and relax, allowing each participant to be oneself....and in a really nice loft characterized by its style, good taste and quality it becomes into a really enjoyable activity. The classes are participatory (hands-on) and include all the ingredients, aprons, equipment, tasting of all the dishes and recipes.









5. Boca Juniors Stadium "Football Passion"

Argentine soccer is known worldwide, and so are one of the main teams Boca Juniors.

Experience how Boca Juniors XXI century gladiator battle for the entertainment and passion of the roaring crowds.



6. Fileteado Porteño Workshop

The fileteado porteño was born in Buenos Aires at the beginning of the 20th century as a popular decorative technique. It originated in wagon factories, where the first practitioners of the trade slowly developed it until it fully matured with shapes and color.

Because of its development as a spontaneous, popular art form, there is very little documentation on fileteado: there is no exact date that marks its birth, or a first artist for the genre. For this reason, the history of fileteado is formed from individual testimonies.







7. Silversmith workshop at Marcelo Toledo atelier

Marcelo Toledo, with only 37 years old, is one of the most recognized silversmiths of Argentina. He began selling his pieces in Caminito street, La Boca, but today his silver pieces adorn the mansions of international kings and stars.

At the moment, he is the only Argentine silversmith that managed to land in Broadway (he reproduced the Evita jewels, the musical where Elena Roger and Ricky Martin are the performers) thanks to his perfect creations.



8. Graffiti Tour

This experience reveal the extraordinary history of Buenos Aires' vibrant urban art culture. From its fiery political origins to the present day, where the city has become one of the world's most exciting locations for street art, you'll get an in-depth view into what makes this fascinating city explode with culture and creativity.

The tours are developed and conducted in close collaboration with local artists, enabling us to share their personal stories and inspirations, alongside some of he most spectacular art in the city.





9. Bike Tour in the north part of the city

Enjoy a scenic bike ride around the city's most beautiful spots, organized by fun and professional guides.

Guides supply the bikes, helmets, child seats when needed, medical assistance, beverages, and snacks.

The tour includes rides through Recoleta, Puerto Madero, Palermo Parks, & Palermo Soho.

Day 3 - Full Day Activities

Option 1. Glimpse of Pampa's Life at Estancia La Republica

Visit a beautiful and traditional Estancia, located in the countryside of Buenos Aires, 1 hour and 15 minutes away from the city.

Enjoy a welcome reception with delicious empanadas and local wine.

Get to know about the Argentinian "Gauchos" and their horses with an impressive equestrian show and then enjoy a typical Asado (Argentinian barbecue).







Option 2. La Aguada Polo Club

Only 65 km away from Buenos Aires, near the town of Open Door, lays La Aguada Polo Clinic & Resort. A farm of 300 hectares, crossed by streams, with more than 250 horses in training, 5 polo fields and 2 stick & ball fields, where guests find the ideal lodging to enjoy a real farm life experience.

Option 3. Private Polo Day & Lunch at Campo Argentino de Polo

Known around the World as "the Cathedral of Polo", the Campo Argentino de Polo is located in Palermo neighborhood, 10 minutes distance from the most important hotels of Buenos Aires.

It is a classic venue where the Argentine Open Polo Tournament takes place every year. The competition is recognised as the most important inter-club polo tournament in the world, and one of the most exciting sporting events anyone can see.

Option 4. El Descanso Private Island

Option1. Farewell Dinner at El Zanjon de Granados


Purchased as a derelict site in 1985, the owners of what is now El Zanjon de Granados had no idea the stories the building held.

Originally a mansion, by the end 19th century, the building had been abandoned (later to be turned into tenement housing) due to the yellow fever outbreak of 1871 in which wealthy proteños fled San Telmo for the more northern barrios.

As renovations on the property began, it became apparent that El Zanjon de Granados was one of the most important archeological sites in Buenos Aires. Beneath its foundations, workers found tunnels from the old city, founded in 1536, but lost for over 400 years.

Now a sprawling, beautifully renovated complex, El Zanjon de Granados is the perfect event space. A blend of modern design mixed with historical architecture, the building offers a fascinating glimpse into five centuries of urban archaeology as the backdrop for your next occasion.









Option 2. Farewell Dinner & Tango Show at La Ventana

In the heart of San Telmo neighborhood, La Ventana Tango opened its doors to the world in 1982. This fully restored historic tenement is a classic walk-through Buenos Aires culture through time.

Their proposal counts with 32 artists on stage: two tango orchestras, a set of folk music, dancers and singers.

The menu includes international and local dishes of our country, with traditional grill and a large menu of Argentine wines.











Option 3. Farewell Dinner & Tango Show at Cafe De Los Angelitos

Talking about Rivadavia and Rincón is talking about a corner of tango, about the Café de los Angelitos, about the morning, midday, afternoon and night of the most traditional coffee house of Buenos Aires.

From Monday to Monday, this emblematic meeting place for outstanding national celebrities from culture, politics, sports and arts, is proud to open its doors to receive new visitors.

With a series of 350 especially selected photographs placed on its walls, a stage box where, at some moment during the day, a live large accordion can be heard, and a moderate and elegant decoration, it will recreate the atmosphere and the environment of the 20th century for the visitors.









IGUAZU

One of the most enchanting, awe-inspiring locations on the entire planet, the Iguazú Falls are simply astonishing! A collection of 275 separate waterfalls, spanning over 2 miles (3 kilometers), experiencing the sheer majesty falls - the power and noise of the rushing water - is something that cannot be forgotten!

Located close to Puerto Iguazú on the Argentinian side of the border, and Foz do Iguaçu on the Brazilian side, a trek to these majestic falls - a UNESCO World Heritage Site - doesn't mean you have to forgo the comforts of home. A perfect balance between cosmopolitan and rustic, both cities feature a wide array of amenities, including delicious, world-class cuisine, exciting nightlife, and luxurious hotels!




Macuco Safari Adventure








BBQ Dinner under the stars at Belmond Hotel gardens
